Are the kids alright?

Looking at the percentages of drinking alcohol between 7th and 12th grade--where is the biggest jump in the data in recent/30 day alcohol misuse?



Between 9th and 10th grade

During this time, the percentage of teens who drink goes from 17% to 36%.

While as parents and caregivers, we are always "on," it is especially important during this time to use our prevention strategies!

Are the kids alright?

Looking at the percentages of drinking alcohol between 7th and 12th grade--where is the 2nd Biggest jump in the data in recent/30 day alcohol misuse?



Between 8th and 9th grade

During this time, the percentage of teens who drink goes from 6% to 17%.

While as parents and caregivers, we are always "on," it is especially important during this time to use our prevention strategies!

Are the kids alright?

Do more 11th graders or 12th graders engage in more recent/30 day alcohol misuse?



11th grade students

45% of 11th graders report that they consumed alcohol in the past 30 days, while 42% of 12th grade students reported that behavior.

However, when it comes to binge drinking, it is 12th graders whose percentage is higher - 23% for 11th graders and 32% for 12th graders.

What percentage of high school students perceive **little or no** parental/caregiver disapproval of teen drinking drink alcohol regularly?

The Power of Parents/Caregivers

When parents/caregivers talk to their teen about alcohol, how much less likely is their teen to drink alcohol?



50% less likely!

Let's See How Parents/Caregivers Think & Feel About Underage Drinking



What percentage of surveyed Scituate parents think that teens getting drunk occasionally is NOT ok?



More of us than you might have guessed!

98%!

Yes, 98% of us think that underage drinking is NOT ok. 98% of us also think it is NOT ok to drink underage under the supervision of a friend's parents, and 98% of us also think it is NOT ok to drink without supervision, even when there is no driving involved.



Not everyone is doing it...

While surveyed parents/caregivers believed 52% of SHS students drink alcohol, the real number is...
